April 28, 2024 This morning's message is part of our ongoing study of the Book of Daniel; and is taken from Daniel 3:1-30

THE FOURTH IN THE FURNACE

It's no coincidence that this chapter begins with the command to bow to a great image. God had shown King Nebuchadnezzar an image in which he was the 'head of gold' (Daniel 2); and in arrogance, he created his own version and demanded that all people bow to it. This story is a picture of the challenge that God's faithful people will endure while living in 'the times of the Gentiles'.

But it also has a great message of encouragement for those throughout the ages who—in devotion to God—refuse to bow to the false idols of man. It teaches us that <u>our Lord stands faithfully in the midst of the trial with</u> those who stand faithfully for Him.

1. THE KING'S COMMAND (vv. 1-7). (See also Daniel 11:31; Matthew 24:15-21; Revelation 13:14-15.)

- 2. THE FAITHFUL RESOLVE (vv. 8-18). (See also Exodus 20:3-6; Acts 5:29.)
- **3.** THE FOURTH IN THE MIDST (vv. 19-25). (See Hebrews 11:32-40; Isaiah 43:1-3.)
- 4. THE FAITHFULNESS OF GOD (vv. 26-30). (See 1 Peter 4:12-19.)

(Leader reads the italicized text; congregation reads the boldfaced text)

He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High Shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.

I will say of the Lord, "He is my refuge and my fortress; My God, in Him I will trust."

Surely He shall deliver you from the snare of the fowler And from the perilous pestilence. He shall cover you with His feathers, And under His wings you shall take refuge; His truth shall be your shield and buckler. You shall not be afraid of the terror by night, Nor of the arrow that flies by day, Nor of the pestilence that walks in darkness, Nor of the destruction that lays waste at noonday.
