

July 14, 2024 This morning's message is part of our ongoing study from the Old Testament Book of Daniel; and is taken from Daniel 7:13-14

THE EVERLASTING KINGDOM

In the context of his vision from God of the beastly nations of this world, Daniel tells us of how he saw "one like the Son of Man", to whom an everlasting kingdom will be given. In this vision, found in Daniel 7:13-14, we're given a picture of the sure and certain reign of God's appointed King (see Psalm 2). It's important that we look at it carefully; because the details of Daniel's vision of 'The Son of Man' give us cause for victorious hope in troubled times. Notice ...

- 1. THE CONTEXT IN WHICH THE VISION WAS GIVEN. (See Daniel 7:9-10.)
- 2. WHO IT WAS THAT DANIEL 'BEHELD'. (See Matthew 24:29-31.)
- 3. HOW IT WAS THAT HE 'CAME'. (See Acts 1:11; Revelation 1:7.)
- 4. **BEFORE WHOM IT WAS THAT HE WAS BROUGHT NEAR.** (See Revelation 5:1-12.)
- 5. WHAT IT WAS THAT HE WAS GIVEN. 'Dominion' = authority; 'Glory' = honor; 'A kingdom' = sovereign power
- 6. WHY THESE THINGS WERE GIVEN TO HIM. (See Philippians 2:9-11.)
- 7. HOW LONG THESE THINGS WILL ENDURE AS HIS POSSESSION. (See Daniel 7:27.)
