# THE PRAYER OF ONE GREATLY BELOVED

Daniel was not only a biblical prophet of God. He was also a student of biblical prophecy. He had studied God's prophetic promises to Jeremiah; and he learned that the promised 70 years of captivity were about to end for his people.

But Daniel didn't simply sit by and watch it happen. He prayed an earnest prayer of confession for his people—and God responsed to that prayer by giving him a clear prophetic time-table for the future of the Jewish people.

Daniel's prayer is a model prayer that illustrates to us that we pray rightly for the sins of our people when we relate ourselves to the burden of their repentance.

- 1. THE CONTEXT OF THE PRAYER (vv. 1-3; see also Jeremiah 25:8-12; 29:10-14.)
- 2. THE CONTENT OF THE PRAYER (vv. 4-19).
  - a. Worship (v. 4; see also Exodus 34:6-8).
  - b. Confession (vv. 5-10; see also Ezekiel 16:27).
  - c. Recognition of God's Justice (vv. 11-15; see also Leviticus 26:33-35; 2 Chronicles 36:20-21.)
  - d. A Plea for Mercy (vv. 16-19).
- 3. THE RESPONSE TO THE PRAYER (vv. 20-23).
