September 22, 2024 This morning's message is part of our ongoing study of the Old Testament Book of Daniel; and is taken from Daniel 11:21-35

PURIFIED BY A VILE KING

Antiochus IV Ephiphanes was a Syrian king who ruled from 175-164 B.C. An angel gave Daniel a vision regarding this wicked tyrant 350 years before he came on the scene. It was promised that he would be a particularly fierce oppressor of the Jewish people (Daniel 8:9-12)--and that he would serve as a picture of an even more vicious ruler who is yet to arise (vv. 23-25).

And yet, God had this vile king in the palm of His hand, and used him to refine His people through the trial of oppression. As this passage shows us, the testing of God's people through times of persecution results in their purification before Him. We see this from the story of Antiochus' ...

- 1. APPEARANCE IN HISTORY (v. 21).
- 2. ACQUISITION OF POWER (vv. 22-23).
- 3. CLEVER POLITICS (vv. 24-26).
- 4. TREACHEROUS NATURE (vv. 27-28).

- 6. RESISTANCE FROM THE JEWS (vv. 32-33).
- 7. USEFULNESS TO GOD (vv. 34-35).
