This morning's message is the final segment of our ongoing study of the Old Testament Book of Daniel; and is taken from Daniel 12:5-13


LIMITED, SEALED & TIMED

These closing words of the Book of Daniel give us the capstone to the whole book; and are meant to give courage to God's people in respect to the events of 'the time of the end'. And those event—as is true of all prophetic portions of the Bible—point us to Jesus (Revelation 19:10; John 5:39).

In this closing passage, Daniel was shown—by an angelic messenger—that the events that lead to the return of our Lord are limited, sealed, and timed according to God's redemptive plan ...

- 1. LIMITED IN DURATION (vv. 5-7). (See Daniel 12:1-3; Deuteronomy 19:15; Daniel 7:25.)
- 2. SEALED FROM HUMAN INVESTIGATION (vv. 8-10). (See Hebrews 1:1-2; Revelation 22:10-11; Malachi 3:2-3; Zechariah 13:7-9.)
- 3. TIMED FOR GOD'S REDEMPTIVE PURPOSE (vv. 11-13). (See Revelation 12:6; Ezekiel 20:33-38; Matthew 25:46.)

Conclusion: 1 Corinthians 15:58.
