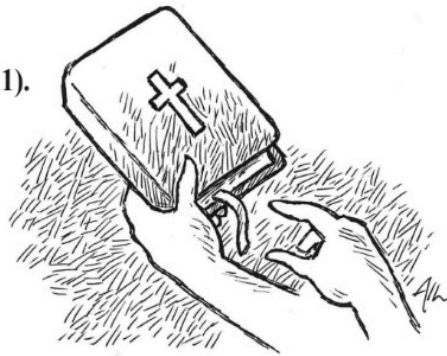
This morning's message is part of our ongoing study of the New Testament book of 1 Timothy; and is taken from 1 Timothy 1:1-11

TEACH NO OTHER DOCTRINE!

Timothy—a young pastor over the church in Ephesus—had a very serious task to fulfill. The apostle Paul—his mentor and spiritual ‘father in the faith’—urged him to protect the integrity of the church’s teaching and preaching ministry (see Acts 20:28-31).

Paul’s initial command to Timothy in this letter is something that we urgently need to embrace (see 1 Timothy 6:20; 3:14-16; 4:1-3). It reminds us that the church is to teach no other doctrine than the gospel of grace through faith in Jesus Christ. Notice ...

1. **THE AFFECTION BEHIND THE COMMAND (vv. 1-2).**
(See Acts 16:1; 2 Timothy 1:2; 3:10-11).
2. **THE CONTENT OF THE COMMAND (vv. 3-4).**
(See 1 Timothy 6:3-5; 2 Timothy 4:3-5.)
3. **THE REASON FOR THE COMMAND (vv. 5-7).**
(See 1 Peter 1:5-7.)
4. **THE THEOLOGY SUPPORTING THE COMMAND (vv. 8-10).**
(See Galatians 3:19-25; Romans 10:4.)
5. **THE STANDARD GIVEN FOR THE COMMAND (v. 11).**
(See Galatians 1:11-12.)
