HOLINESS IN OUR PRAYERS

Our God is a holy God. And so, how we approach Him together in our prayers as a church family must also be holy (see Leviticus 10:3). In 1 Timothy 2:8-10, we find instructions that the apostle Paul gave to Pastor Timothy regarding the holy conduct that must characterize God's people in prayer. In these words, Paul teaches us that <u>prayer in church to a holy God must be</u> offered in a holy way by all His redeemed people.


1. BY HOLY MEN (v. 8) ...

- Who initiate prayer in every place. (See 1 Corinthians 1:2; 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18).
- Who lift up holy hands in prayer. (See Psalm 66:18; Isaiah 1:15.)
- Who pray from uncontentious hearts. (See Matthew 5:21-24; 1 Peter 3:7).

2. BY HOLY WOMEN (vv. 9-10) ...

- With respectability of manner. (See 1 Timothy 3:2.)
- With modesty of adornment. (See Titus 2:3-5.)
- With good works of godliness. (See 1 Peter 3:3-4; Acts 9:36; 16:15; Romans 16:2.)
