This morning's message is part of our ongoing study from the New Testament epistle of 1 Timothy, and is taken from 1 Timothy 2:11-15

# GOD'S GRACE THROUGH EVE

The story of Adam and Eve in Genesis 1-3 is a foundational story for our faith. It contains not only the story of humanity's fall, but also the promise that the Seed of the woman would bruise the head of the serpent (Genesis 3:15). In writing to Pastor Timothy, the apostle Paul urged that the manner and conduct of worship in the church reflect the truth of that old story.

In 1 Timothy 2:11-15 we're taught that the worship in church must honor the way that God has provided salvation for us through Eve's promised 'Seed'. In it, we see ...

1. HOW HOLY WOMEN OF THE CHURCH ARE TO CONDUCT THEMSELVES (vv. 11-12).

(See 1 Timothy 2:2; 1 Thessalonians 4:11; Ephesians 5:22-24.)

- 2. WHY THEY MUST CONDUCT THEMSELVES IN THIS WAY (vv. 13-14). (See 1 Corinthians 11:8-12.)
- 3. WHAT MESSAGE OF HOPE IS BEING PROCLAIMED TO THE WORLD AS THEY DO SO (v. 15).

## **Congregational Scripture Reading: Romans 5:18-21 (nkjv)**

(Leader reads the italicized text; Congregation reads the boldfaced text)
