This morning's message is part of our ongoing study from the New Testament epistle of 1 Timothy, and is taken from 1 Timothy 4:1-5

A 'LATTER TIMES' WARNING

The apostle Paul was very diligent to urge Pastor Timothy to protect the doctrine of the gospel of Jesus. He told him to charge some in the church to teach 'no other doctrine' (1:3-7); telling him that some had already rejected the faith and made shipwreck of their spiritual lives (1:18-20).

In this morning's passage, Paul teaches that we must diligently cling to the truth of God's word daily, because some will turn away in times to come.

1. THE DANGER OF TURNING AWAY (v. 1a).

(See 1 Timothy 3:16; 2 Thessalonians 2:3; Luke 8:11-15.)

2. THE RESULTS OF TURNING AWAY (vv. 1b-3).

— **Listening instead to diabolical teaching.**

(See Luke 11:24-26.)

— **Uttering falsehoods in a hypocritical spirit.**

(See 2 Peter 2:1-3.)

— **Searing one's own conscience into insensitivity.**

(See Ephesians 4:19.)

— **Enforcing a system of 'spirituality' through legalistic rules.**

(See Colossians 2:20-23.)

3. THE PREVENTION OF TURNING AWAY (vv. 4-5).
