This morning's message is part of our ongoing study of the New Testament book of 1 Timothy; and is taken from 1 Timothy 5:1-2

CHURCH FAMILY TENDERNESS

As God's household, the church ought to be the place where God's people show the greatest possible love, courtesy and respect for one another. Paul taught Pastor Timothy that the pastor of the church should take the lead in tender care toward God's people (2 Timothy 2:24-26)—setting an example for all.

In giving instructions to Timothy regarding the care of the church, Paul showed that all people in the church ought to be shown the tenderness and respect that is appropriate to their place in the family. These two verses show us:

1. THE RECIPIENTS OF FAMILY TENDERNESS ...

*To believing men and women of all age groups
(See Titus 2:1-8).*

- Older Men (*Leviticus 19:32*).
- Younger Men (*2 Thessalonians 3:15*).
- Older Women (*John 19:26-27; Romans 16:13*).
- Younger Women (*1 Timothy 4:12*).

2. THE MANNER OF FAMILY TENDERNESS ...

*In a way that's respectful of each believer's place in the family
(See 1 Thessalonians 5:14-15).*

3. THE NECESSITY OF FAMILY TENDERNESS ...

*Because we're called to help one another grow in Christ
(See 1 Timothy 1:3-4; James 5:19-20; Galatians 6:1-2).*
