June 8, 2025 This morning's message is part of our ongoing study of the New Testament letter of 1 Timothy; and is taken from 1 Timothy 6:11-12

AN EXAMPLE WORTH FOLLOWING

After having warned Pastor Timothy of the kinds of moral failures that others fell victim to (1 Timothy 6:3-10), the apostle Paul urged him to 'flee' those things. But it's not enough to know what to run from. He also told Timothy the things that he should 'run toward'. In doing so, he set an example for the rest of the church family (1 Peter 5:1-4; 1 Timothy 4:12-16).

As this passage shows us, <u>the pastor must set an example of devoted</u> <u>Christian living that's worthy of being followed by God's people</u>. He must be an example of ...

1. WHAT TO FLEE FROM (v. 11a). (See 1 Corinthians 6:18; 10:14; 2 Timothy 2:22.)

2. WHAT TO CHASE AFTER (v. 11b).

3. WHAT TO CONTEND FOR (v. 12a). (See 1 Corinthians 9:24-27; Jude 3.)

4. WHAT TO LAY HOLD OF (v. 12b). (See Philippians 3:12-14; 1 Timothy 6:13.)
