# THANKSGIVING & CHRISTIAN LIVING Thanksgiving is crucial to the Christian life (1 Thessalonians 5:18). And

Thanksgiving is crucial to the Christian life (1 Thessalonians 5:18). And Paul's letter to the Colossian believers has several mentions of "thanksgiving". It's a major theme of the letter.

As we skim our way through it, we find that it teaches us that <u>sincere</u>, <u>ongoing thanksgiving to God is a crucial habit for healthy Christian living</u> ...

1. IT'S WHAT WE DO TO ACKNOWLEDGE OUR SALVATION.

(Colossians 1:12; see also Psalm 116:12-13, 16-17.)

2. IT'S WHAT HELPS US TO GROW IN THE STRENGTH OF OUR FAITH.

(Colossians 2:6-7; see also Philippians 4:11-13.)

3. IT'S WHAT UNITES US IN PEACEFUL FELLOWSHIP WITH EACH OTHER.

(Colossians 3:15; see also Ephesians 4:14-16.)

4. IT'S WHAT SANCTIFIES OUR WORKS OF SERVICE TO THE LORD.

(Colossians 3:17; see also 1 Timothy 4:3-5.)

5. IT'S WHAT HELPS TO EMPOWER OUR PRAYERS.

(Colossians 4:2; see also 1 John 5:14-15.)
