This morning's message is part of our ongoing study of the New Testament book of 2 Timothy; and is taken from 2 Timothy 2:11-13

A SONG FOR THE FAITHFUL

The Bible seems to contain the lyrics of what might have been ancient Christian hymns (See Philippians 2:6-11; Colossians 1:15-20; 1 Timothy 3:16). In his instructions to Pastor Timothy, the apostle Paul seems to draw from one of them to teach that we must faithfully endure for the gospel of our Lord--because faithfulness is rewarded, but unfaithfulness results in loss.

Notice ...

AN INTRODUCTION (v. 11a).

"This is a faithful saying ..."
(See 1 Timothy 1:15; 3:1; 4:9; Titus 3:8.)

LINE 1: About Trusting His Resurrection (v. 11b).

"For if we died with Him, / We shall also live with Him." (See Luke 14:26-33; Romans 6:1-11; Galatians 2:20.)

LINE 2: About Looking Ahead To His Reign (v. 12a.)

"If we endure, / We shall also reign with Him." (See Romans 8:16-17; 2 Timothy 1:12.)

LINE 3: About Not Denying Him Under Pressure (v. 12b).

"If we deny Him, / He also will deny us." (See Matthew 10:32-33; Mark 8:38.)

LINE 4: About Remembering His Faithfulness (v. 13).

"If we are faithless, / He remains faithful; / He cannot deny Himself." (See Malachi 3:6; Philippians 1:6.)

A CONCLUSION (v. 14a):

"Remind them of these things ..."
