TAKING THE LORD AT HIS WORD

This morning's passage tells us the story of a man who had faith in Jesus to heal his sick and dying son. At first, his faith in Jesus only went so far as he could actually have Jesus present and actually see Him perform a miracle. But the Lord challenged him to grow in a deeper faith—one that simply trusted in the authority of Jesus' word.

The Bible teaches us that without faith, it's impossible to please our Lord (Hebrews 1:6). And the story of this man teaches us a lesson about the kind of faith that truly pleases Him. It shows us that we must grow from a faith that has to see miracles to a faith that simply trusts in the word.

1. **IT MUST BEGIN WITH SINCERE A FAITH IN JESUS' POWER (vv. 46-47).**
(See John 2:23-25.)
2. **BUT IT MUST MOVE PAST BEING A FAITH THAT DEPENDS ON HAVING TO SEE MIRACLES (vv. 48-50a.)**
(See 1 Corinthians 1:22-23; Mark 7:24-30.)
3. **IT MUST GROW INTO A FAITH THAT TRUSTS IN AND OBEYS JESUS' WORD (vv. 50b-54.)**
(See John 20:24-29.)

Luke 7:1-10*
